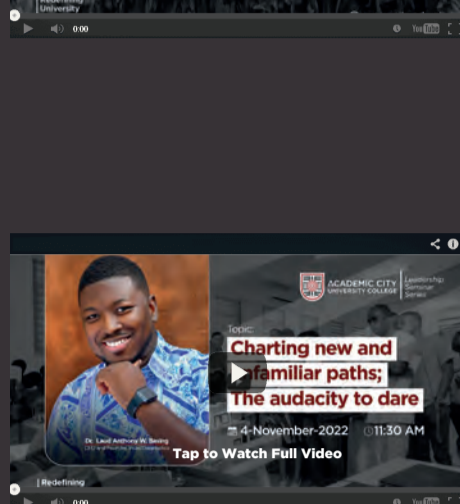

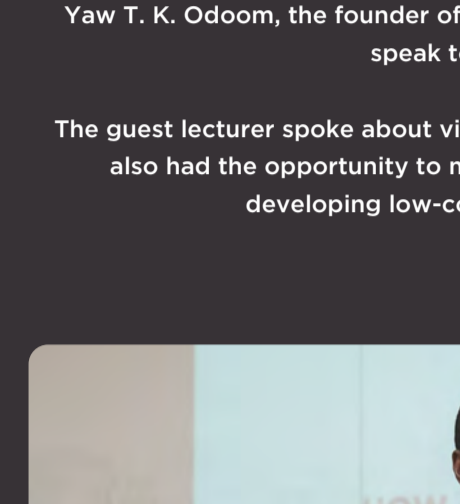
TIME WITH HON. SAMUEL OKUDZETO ABLAKWA

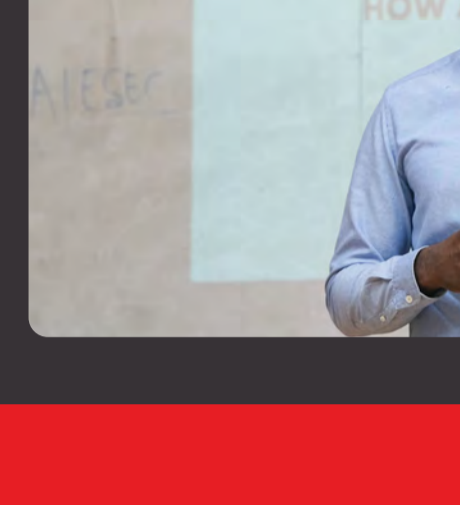
TIME WITH MANASSEH AWUNI AZURE

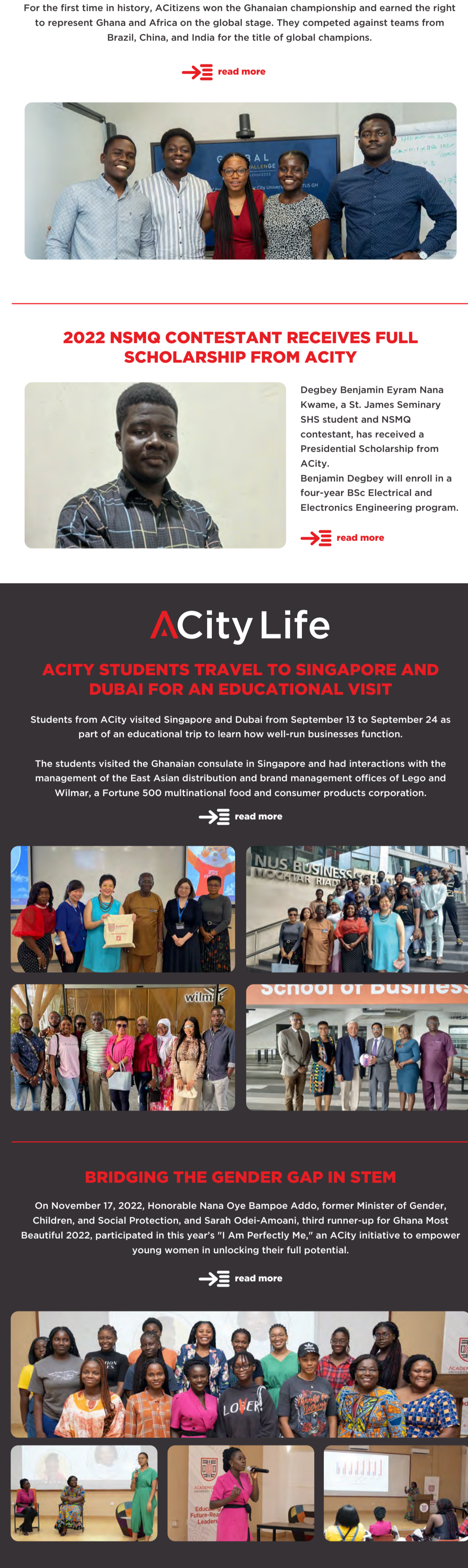


SEMINAR BY YAW T.K. ODOOM

Yaw T. K. Odoom, the founder of Troto diaries and Bachelors in the Kitchen, was invited to speak to the Technology & Society class.

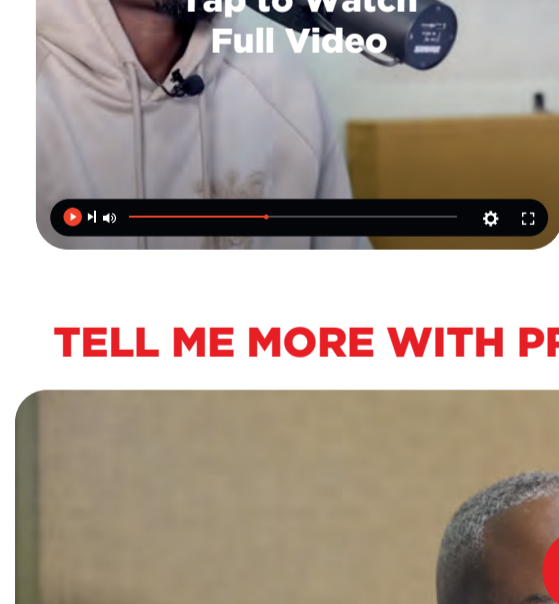

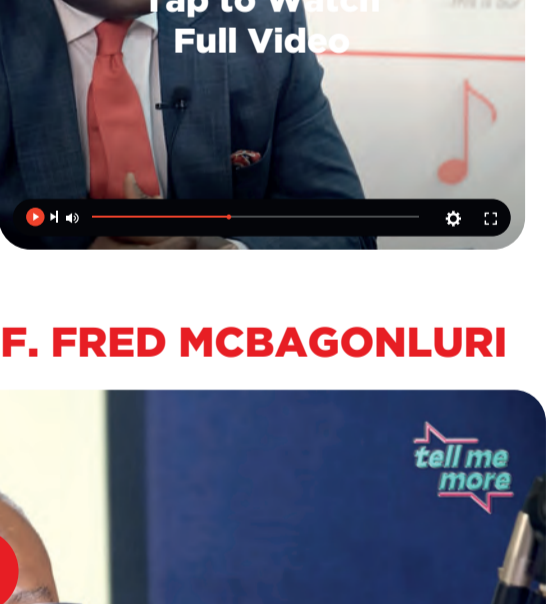
ACITY PARTNERS MAKELAB, EMBASSY OF ISRAEL TO IMPROVE YOUTH EMPLOYABILITY
