ACADEMIC CITY HOLDS 3RD GRADUATION CEREMONY

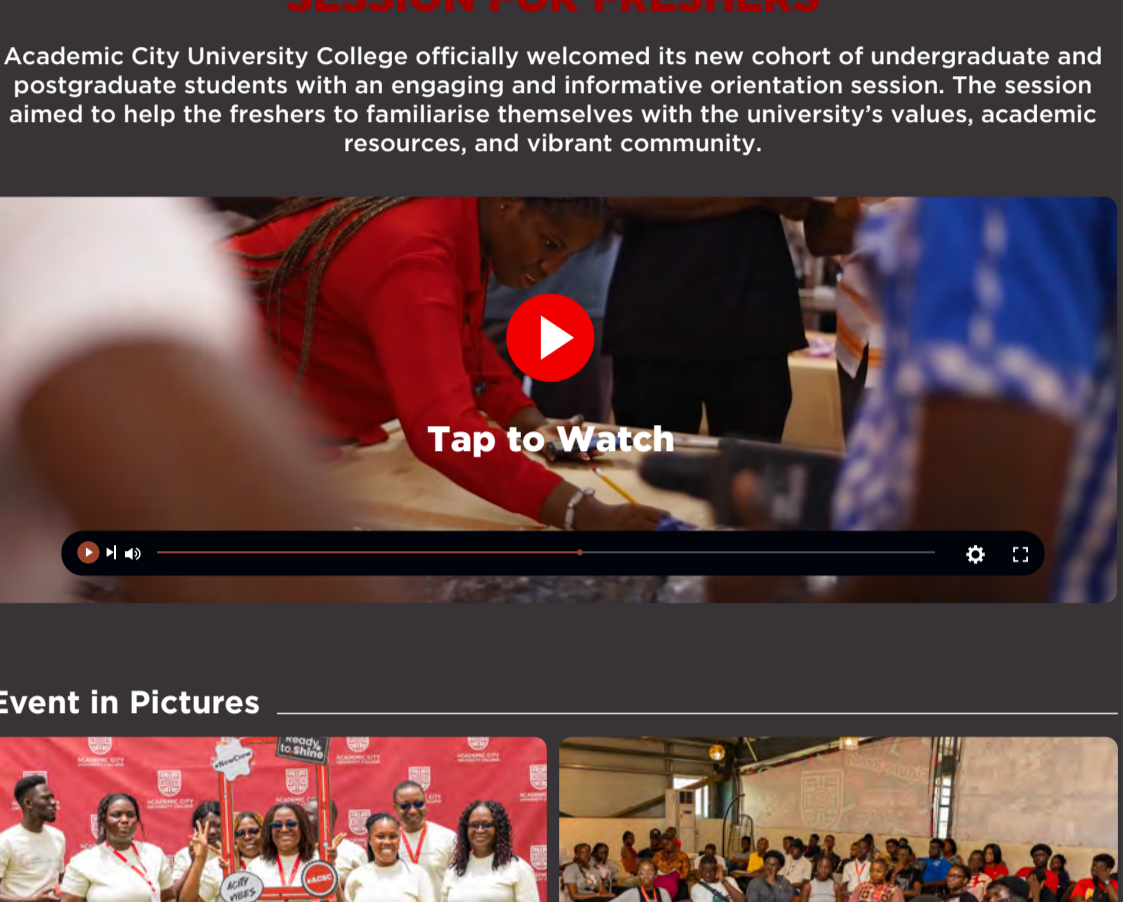
The commencement ceremony for the third graduating class was held on Saturday, July 27, 2024. 67 graduates received degree certificates in engineering, business, information technology and communication arts.

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ACADEMIC CITY PARTNERS IMPLEMENTERS TO ENHANCE ACADEMIC GROWTH

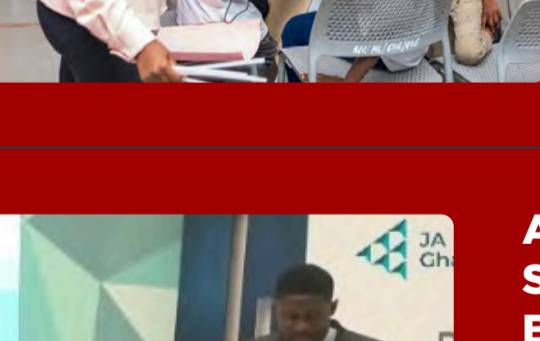

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ACADEMIC CITY AND IMPLEMENTERS TRAIN ORPHANS IN TECHNOLOGY

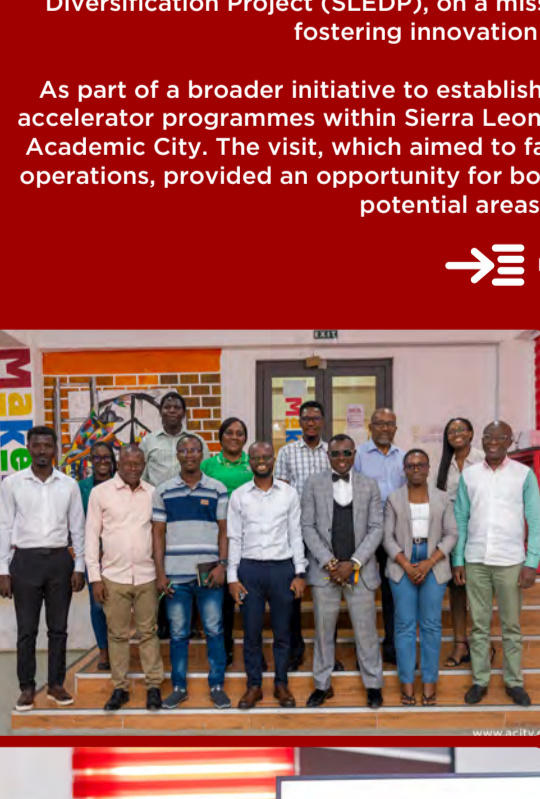
